

2015 – 2016 Annual Scholarship Announcement 4-Year University or College

The Arizona Hydrological Society (AHS) will award **three \$2,000 student Scholarships** for the academic year. Funding will be provided by AHS and the AHS Foundation. The purpose of the award is to encourage full-time students in hydrology, hydrogeology, or other water resources related field <u>at an Arizona university or college</u> to excel in their area of study. Any **junior**, **senior**, or **graduate student** who fits into this category is qualified to apply for the Scholarship. **Deadline for mailing applications for the Scholarship is April 30, 2015**. The Scholarship will be awarded during the Annual Symposium of the Society on September 16-18, 2015, at the Desert Willow Conference Center, Phoenix, Az.

The Scholarship award will be based upon the following criteria:

- 1. Grade Point Average based on at least **four full semesters** of course work
- 2. Strength of letter(s) of recommendation (at least one)
- 3. Application letter describing applicant's interests / career goals in hydrology & water resources
- 4. Background in hydrology and water resources related activities (provided in applicant's resume)
- 5. Degree of need explain need for support and list relevant 2015-2016 awards
- 6. Previous winners of this academic scholarship are <u>not eligible</u> for this award, but <u>are eligible</u> for the separately administered AHS intern scholarship program

The Scholarship Application must include at least the following documents to be considered:

- 1. Application form (available at AHS web site below)
- 2. Application letter, including description of financial need. List all scholarships, internships, student aid, or financial awards that you will be receiving for the 2015 2016 academic year
- 3. Official transcripts (graduate & undergraduate for graduate applicants)
- 4. <u>Confidential</u> recommendation letters (<u>at least one</u>)
- 5. Paper copies of all documents are <u>required</u>. However, please also send copies in Adobe® portable document format (PDF) to the **AHS Scholarships** e-mail address below:
